ANSWERS TO CLARIFICATION QUESTIONS – ISSUE No. 1 (Questions 1-2)

Question 1:	<p>With regard to Section I of Part 1 of the Bidding Documents - Instructions to Bidders (ITB) 8.2 titled <i>“Clarification of Bidding Document, Site Visit, pre-Bid Conference”</i> states <i>“The Bidder is advised to visit and examine the Site of Works and its surroundings and obtain for itself, on its own responsibility, all information that may be necessary for preparing the Bid and entering into a Contract for construction of the Works.....”</i></p> <p>Please kindly confirm if the Bidder may visit the Site on its own responsibility and cost prior the stated visit date of February 13 and 14, 2023.</p>
Answer 1:	<p>As stated in Section II of Part 1 of the Bidding Documents - Bid Data Sheet - ITB 8.2 <i>“Bidders may visit the route of the Conveyance System at their own risk, however access to CHPP #3 and CHPP #4 will not be granted.”</i></p> <p>Visiting the route of the Conveyance System without accessing CHPP #3 and/or CHPP #4 may be done at any time during the Bidding period. Bidders can do this in addition to attending the Site Visits organized by MCA-Mongolia on February 13 and 14, 2023.</p> <p>As per Bid Data Sheet ITB 8.2, a reminder was sent to all registered Bidders on January 17, 2023 - MCA-Mongolia is highly recommending that potential Bidders attend the site visit(s) for the adequate understanding of the site conditions.</p> <p>In order to participate in the Site Visits, Bidders must download the Registration Form, complete and return it with a visit request letter with personal information of its participant(s). The letter shall at a minimum contain a copy of the participant(s) Passport or Mongolian ID. This must be provided no later January 30, 2023, this being 14 days before the site visit - as entry to CHPP's will require prior permission from the CHPP guard unit. Question 2:	<p>With regard to Section II of Part 1 of the Bidding Documents - Bid Data Sheet - ITB 21.5 states: <i>“The written confirmation of authorization to sign on behalf of the Bidder shall consist of: Power of Attorney, Board resolution or document(s) providing or demonstrating legal authorization to an individual.”</i></p> <p>A Power of Attorney is deemed as a document that provides legal authorization to an individual. Please kindly confirm if only Power of Attorney is sufficient.</p>
Answer 2:	<p>A Power of Attorney (POA) or any other document mentioned in the ITB 21.5 is sufficient if it provides or demonstrates legal authorization to an individual to sign a bid on behalf of the bidder.</p>
