Warranty certificate shall clearly state equipment's serial number, warranty period and contact information of the local agent/representative of the Supplier. The warranty for all the equipment items shall remain valid for 12 months after the Goods have been fully installed and put into service, as certified by MCA Mongolia and USUG.
