Qualification and Evaluation Criteria of the RFP.

Question 9:	What is requirement for partner of join venture or subcontractor in terms of experience: 3.7.4.1 Organization Capability and Technical Experience?
Answer 9:	According to the Table 3.7 (Qualification Table) of the Section III. Qualification and Evaluation Criteria of the RFP, the requirements of Sub-Factor 3.7.4.1 (Organization Capability and Technical Experience) must be met by the Consultant (Single Entity or all members of Joint Venture combined).
	Organizational Capacity and Technical Experience of the sub-consultants will not be evaluated according to requirement of the Sub-Factor 3.7.4.1 of the of the Section III. Qualification and Evaluation Criteria of the RFP.
Question 10:	There were some clauses in the RFP that above 100,000\$ sub-contractor should be approved by MCC. Please give more information on this requirement
Answer 10:	According to Clause 5 of the Section IV (General Conditions of the Contract) of the RFP: If the Consultant intends to subcontract for a major item of its contracted Services (deemed major if valued in excess of \$100,000 USD) it shall seek the MCA Entity's prior written approval of the subcontractor. Subcontracting shall not alter the Consultant's obligations under this Contract.
Question 11:	Is it right that technical experience of sub-contractor is not evaluated and considered?
Answer 11:	According to the Table 3.7 (Qualification Table) of the Section III. Qualification and Evaluation Criteria of the RFP, the Sub-Consultant(s) Must meet at least one specialized requirement of Sub-Factor 3.7.4.2 (General & Specific Experience). Organizational Capacity and Technical Experience of the sub-consultants will not be evaluated according to requirement of the Sub-Factor 3.7.4.1 of the of the Section III. Qualification and Evaluation Criteria of the RFP.
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Question 12:	Reference Special Conditions of Contract (Part 2 Contract Documents): "GCC 10.5: A resident project manager shall be required for the duration of this Contract".
	The draft contract in the RFP requires the project manager to reside in Mongolia during the entire contract. This will result in large costs for MCA due to expatriate

	living and travel costs. May we propose interim visits by the Project Manager and when requested by MCA as an alternative approach to save costs (and ensure adequate resources to complete a robust and actionable study) to the Compact?"
Answer 12:	As per requirement of sub-clause 10.5 (Resident Project Manager) of Section I. Instructions to the Consultants of the RFP, the Consultant shall ensure that at all times during the Consultant's performance of the Services a Resident Project Manager, acceptable to the MCA Entity, shall take charge of the performance of such Services in the MCA Country. Responsibilities of the Resident Project Manager can be assigned to any Key or Non-key personnel of the Consultant. Therefore, the role of the Resident Project Manager may not be assigned to the Project Manager (Team Leader).
