## Pre-Qualification of Construction Works of an Advanced Water Purification Plant (AWPP) and SCADA Controls (CP 2)

## ANSWERS TO CLARIFICATION QUESTIONS – ISSUE No. 1 (Questions 1-9) July 10, 2020

Question 1:	There are some qualification requirements for experience as follows.  Each member must meet requirement requested in Clause 2.4.2 Similar Experience, Section III.  All members combined must meet requirement in Clause 2.4.3 ~ Clause 2.4.5, Section III.  I would appreciate it if you could accept similar experience of "All members combined" instead of "Each member" in Clause 2.4.2 same as in Clause 2.4.3 ~ Clause 2.4.5.	
Answer 1:	Clause 2.4.3 relates to "Specific Experience in Key Activities", thus it is acceptable for the J/V as a whole (all members combined) to meet the criterion, as each member may be specialists in specific activities. Clause 2.4.2 however relates "Similar Experience" in terms of the number of projects over a defined period of time, with a specific minimum value, as MCA-Mongolia is seeking to ensure that each J/V member has the capacity to undertake projects of the size and complexity of the subject procurement. The request cannot be therefore considered and shall remain as "Each single entity and/or each member of an association forming an applicant (Each member of a "Joint Venture") must meet the indicative requirement on the similar experience of the sub-factor "2.4.2 Similar Experience" (2.0 Qualification table of the Section III)."

Answer 2:	The contractor will be responsible for installing a SCADA system at the AWPP which will control the AWPP and also control the two remote wellfields. All well-houses at the well fields will be connected to the Operational Control Center (OCC) which is located at the AWPP via a Fiber Optic (FO) cable. The contractor will be responsible for equipping the central SCADA system. However, the FO cable installation work for connecting well-houses to the central SCADA control room will be conducted under a separate construction package. Detailed information of equipment is not available at this stage. It will be provided for pre-qualified bidders.

Answer 3:	The SCADA system installation is a part of the AWPP contractor's scope of works.	

Question 4:	SCADA system budget?		
Answer 4:	The Millennium Challenge Compact for Millennium Challenge Account assistance to help facilitate poverty reduction through economic growth in Mongolia (the "Compact"), provides information on the overall budget of the project. As this is the Pre-qualification stage and not the full bidding stage, applicants are required to submit their application without costs. After completion of the Pre-qualification process, the Invitations for Bid, which will be issued to the qualified applicants, will include the relevant technical specifications, drawings, and bills of quantities. However, the budget estimates for the specific works and/or its different components will remain confidential and will not be published.

Answer 6:	For the Construction of an Advanced Water Purification Plant (AWPP) and SCADA Controls (CP 2), the General Conditions of Contract to be used with the Bidding Documents are the FIDIC Conditions of Contract for Construction, First Edition, 1999, prepared and copyrighted by the "FIDIC" and licensed to MCC (Red Book).

Question 7:	The article 5.4 of Pre-Qualification Document stipulates that "Government-Owned Enterprises ("GOEs") are not eligible to compete for MCC-funded contracts for goods or works. GOEs (a) may not be party to any MCC-funded contract for goods or works procured through an open solicitation process, limited bidding, direct contracting, or sole source selection; and (b) may not be prequalified or shortlisted for any MCC-funded contract for goods or works anticipated to be procured through these means. This prohibition does not apply to Government-owned Force Account units owned by the Government of the Employer's country, or Government-owned educational institutions and research centers, any statistical, mapping or other technical entities not formed primarily for a commercial or business purpose, or where a waiver is granted by MCC in accordance with Part 7 of MCC's Program Procurement Guidelines."  Please kindly clarify if the Government-Owned Enterprises ("GOEs") in this prequalification indicates only the GOEs of the government of Mongolia, or GOEs of all eligible nationalities.		
Answer 7:	No national preferences apply to the MCC-funded procurements.  MCC does not allow government-owned enterprises of any country to compete for contracts for goods or works. MCC may also consider any firm incorporated and organized in a country with a non-market economy to be a government-owned enterprise, which makes the firm ineligible to compete.		
Question 8:	For informational and matchmaking purposes, would it be possible for the MCA		
	to release a list or register of international entities that have expressed interest in participating in the ongoing pre-qualification bid, similar to the list of local Mongolian entities released in the Preliminary Information Pack for Applicants?
