<b>Question 1:</b>	We are interested on bidding on Lot 1 - Part 3. Is this possible or is it mandatory to
	bid on all parts on this lot? We find that the material on that lot has items that are
	not related at all (i.e., computers, metal racks, electronic equipment) We believe the
	3 parts on this lot should be independent to allow a more equitable participation.
Answer 1:	Offerors must submit an Offer for the complete Lots, which includes all items
	contained in <u>all Parts of the respective Lot</u> . As set forth in Section I, Instructions
	to Offerors (ITO) 15.8 and ITO 1.1 of Section II Data Sheet of the Bidding Document
	- Offerors are invited to present Offers for one Lot (Lot 1 OR Lot 2) or both Lots
	(Lot 1 AND Lot 2) and must quote for all items (100%) within each lot,
	otherwise, the specific lot will be rejected.
	No items or Parts of each Lot shall be removed. An interested Offeror is able to source other suppliers and submit the complete Offer under each Lot.
